
Summer Programs - What to Bring

Recommended Packing List:

- ❖ Casual clothing suitable for a changeable climate (typically ranging from 15°C to 30°C approx.) and comfortable footwear (for regular daily use). Please note that some classes and activities may take place outside, so bring warm layers and a waterproof jacket in case of rain, and cool clothes to keep you warm in hotter weather.
- ❖ Sports clothing – optional (Please note– sports cannot be played without suitable footwear, such as trainers. Football studs are not required and not allowed) * Dressier outfits (optional for special evening events)
- ❖ Personal toiletries, including toothbrush, shampoo, shower gel etc
- ❖ Night Clothes/Pyjamas
- ❖ Writing equipment and paper
- ❖ Though not compulsory, we recommend you bring your laptop or tablet with you for classes. For the Computer Science course, this is required.
- ❖ Any prescribed medication (this information must be included on the medical form completed on your online account prior to your arrival)
- ❖ Hand sanitiser
- ❖ Reusable water bottle
- ❖ Travel plug adaptor suitable for UK (these can also be purchased in Cambridge if required, but not necessarily available on the first day)

Note 1: Bed linen and towels will be provided.

Note 2: Limited laundry facilities will be available.

Money: The majority of your expenses are covered by the program fee. Thus, your expenses will be limited to the additional meals as outlined in our program information (usually lunch and occasional dinners), souvenirs and peripheral costs in your free time. An amount of ~£200-£250 per week is a good guide. Many shops, cafes and restaurants only accept contactless payment, so we recommend looking into contactless card or phone options as an alternative to cash. There may also be some optional activities that will be organized as the program progresses. It is worth bringing additional funds available (up to £100 per 2-week course) to cover any extra events. Please note that Reach Cambridge cannot be held responsible for the loss or theft of any money brought with you.

Valuables: We would dissuade you from bringing expensive items with you such as non-essential tech and jewellery, unless they are absolutely necessary. Your cell phone/mobile must be kept turned off at all times during the academic lessons and lectures.
